

Settings

- Allow active content from CDs to run on My Computer*

- Allow software to run or install even if the signature is inv.
- Check for publisher's certificate revocation
- Check for server certificate revocation*
- Check for signatures on downloaded programs
- Do not save encrypted pages to disk
- Empty Temporary Internet Files folder when browser is closed
- Enable Integrated Windows Authentication*
- Enable native XMLHTTP support
- Phishing Filter
 - Disable Phishing Filter
 - Turn off automatic website checking
 - Turn on automatic website checking

Restore advanced settings

Reset Internet Explorer settings

Deletes all temporary files, disables browser add-ons, and resets all the changed settings.
